## Our Vision

## Our Aims

Personal Development promotes the development of qualities and attributes our learners need to thrive as individuals, members of their families and members of the community. Broadwalk Green aims to promote core values through LYFTA, an online platform. Creating an innovative and immersive experience, bringing the topics we are teaching to life with impactful learning experiences that will build character and foster a sense of belonging. Pupils are encouraged to explore 'story worlds', lifting pupils out of their everyday surroundings with transformative opportunities to explore different countries, languages, cultures and lived human experiences from all around the world. Inside every Lyfta story world, you can interact with 360° spaces, rich media, soundscapes and powerful documentaries.

Moral development is when we: Recognise right and wrong; respect the law; understand consequences; investigate moral and ethical issues; offer reasoned views.

Social development is when we: Use a range of social skills; participate in the local community; appreciate diverse viewpoints; participate, volunteer and co-operate; resolve conflict; engage with the 'British values' of democracy, the rule of law, liberty, respect and tolerance.

Cultural development is when we: Appreciate cultural influences; appreciate the role of Britain's parliamentary system; participate in culture opportunities; understand, accept, respect and celebrate diversity
